Albuquerque Little Theater Gets New Bathrooms

The Albuquerque Little Theater (ALT) began in 1930 as a community group to cultivate local appreciation for the theater arts. For their first few years, the group used the KiMo Theater.

In 1936, they moved into their current building on San Pasquale, near Albuquerque's Old Town. The theater has been delighting patrons in the area with shows for nearly 90 years.

Due to their rising popularity over the past decade, ALT had drastically outgrown their restroom facilities, which had six available commodes and outdated plumbing. The theater

began raising funds for an expansion that would open in time to celebrate their 90th season.
